REQUIREMENTS

Students enroll in a 0-credit online course which will guide them as they earn points in five Milestones: Planning & Self-Assessment, Citizenship, Leadership, High Impact Learning, and Knights in the World. Prior college experiences may apply toward these Milestones! As part of this program, students will reflect on their college experiences and create a professional ePortfolio.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, students must have a 2.75 UCF GPA or higher when applying, and a 3.0 UCF GPA or higher by the time they graduate. Students must be actively enrolled full or part time. Students may apply at any time before their graduating semester.

RECOGNITION

Students who successfully complete the program will receive the Knights of Distinction designation on their transcript and a medallion to wear at graduation!

The **Knights of Distinction** program is designed to help you connect the dots between your experiences inside the classroom and beyond. The program provides a framework for you to plan effectively, seek out meaningful, high-impact learning experiences, and leverage those experiences to prepare for what's next!

MILESTONES

Students in the Knights of Distinction program earn 200 total points split across five milestones. Along the way you will have guidance and mentoring to assist you in selecting your experiences and preparing for the next step in your academic, civic, and professional careers.

REFLECTIONS

In the program you'll be writing reflections in each milestone. Through these reflections, you'll learn to identify the valuable skills you've gained as well as those you still need to develop. This will help you communicate these skills to future employers or graduate programs in a way that showcases your value as a candidate.

ePORTFOLIO

Going a step beyond a resume, ePortfolios allow you to provide samples of your work with reflections that tell your story, make connections between your curricular and co-curricular activities, and showcase meaningful experiences. By your last semester in the Knights of Distinction program you will create an ePortfolio. Feedback and resources are available along the way to ensure your ePortfolio is effective, professional, and unique to you.
