### ① Opening ACT:

**A**ctively Involve the Learner

**C**onnect Learning to Past, Present and Future

**T**ell'em what you're gonna tell'em.

- The **Opening Act** should set the stage for learning and evoke anticipation.
- The **Opening Act** should always be planned to "hook" the students' attention within the first minute.

### ② PERFORM:

**P**rovide Clear Directions

**E**xplanations Using Examples

**R**espond to the Learner Appropriately

**F**ormulate Appropriate Questions

**O**rganize Activities

**R**elate Learning to Real-Life

**M**ake Learning Fun

- Teachers should enthusiastically **PERFORM** similar to an actor's performance.

### ③ Curtain CALL:

**C**heck for Understanding

**A**ctively Involve the Learner

**L**ook Back on What You Learned

**L**ook Forward to Future Learning

- A teacher's **Curtain CALL** should always review the essential learning points and plant the seed for future learning.
